1. 'tonecurve/show module' bound to '<Alt>t'
2. switch to darkroom
3. press '<Alt>t'
4. duplicate tonecurve
5. press '<Alt>t'
6. delete first (base) instance of tonecurve
7. press '<Alt>t'
8. -> crash
