Description

Just went to try and keystone an image that I hadn't shot exactly 'square on', set keystone to 'full', adjusted the positions of the 4 red circular control points, clicked out of the Crop and Rotate panel, and no change occurred. You need to double-click in the middle of crop, not outside of it.
