Taken from script:

prefer raw over jpeg: this one is a bit more elaborate, it ignores JPEGs when there is also another file with the same basename, otherwise it allows JPEGs, too

At the moment dt 2.4.1 enables "ignore JPEG" and I would like "prefer RAW over JPEG".
