Description

Hey guys,

I would like to propose an export option to set the dimensions for the "long side" or "short side" of exported images, regardless of orientation.

At the moment (v2.4.4), if you put say, '3000', in the first of the two fields for "Max size", ALL images are exported as 3000 pixels wide.

If you put '3000' in the second field, then all images exported are 3000 pixels high.

Not sure to understand your problem. If you put 3000 in both entries then you can export pictures independently of the orientation. The longer side will be 3000 and the other will be of course reduced keeping the aspect ratio. Seems like this is what you're looking for, no?
