#### Description

It would be very nice to be able to use shotwell's events as image collections.

The term "Film Rolls" seems to be more closely related to shotwell's "imports", hence the proposal to use collections for this.

Maybe it could even be possible to allow full (one-way-) synchronisation of collections with shotwell's events?

This would allow users to use shotwell for all their tagging/sorting/culling and allow them to use DT effectively for post processing their events - uh - collections, of course. :-)
