Using lighttable, single image mode (Alt+1):			
Works as expected: Hovering an image shows the rating for this image. "Right arrow key" moves to the next image. Pressing 5 assigns a 5-star rating to the currently displayed image.			
Doesn't work as expected: If I move the mouse out of the image and press "right arrow key" the next image shows up and the "hover rating" disappears. Pressing 3 assigns a 3-star-rating to the previously displayed image, not the current.			
This issue seems to be related to #9517 .
